Dear Valued Client,

The current weather trends of this season have produced the kind of challenges that warrant adjustments that I have not had to make since the beginning of Nogas Landscaping in 1991. Yet, I have made the necessary adjustments in order to continue to provide the excellent service you have come to expect from Nogas Landscaping.

The month of March exhibited a total of 9 days with 80 degree or more temperatures. Equally challenging was the winter with little to no freeze. To adjust for these variables, our services, including aeration, fertilization, and weed control, began in the middle of March, instead of the April 1st contract date.

To elaborate, past fertilization began April 1st, with weed control following on April 15th. The first application contains a pre-emergent to keep summer grasses from emerging. In order to ensure effectiveness, the chemical must be applied when forsythias are in bloom. Unfortunately, this pre-emergent has a residual of 90-120 days, making it fall short of the worst part of crabgrass season. Hence, the weed control had to be prematurely applied in order to keep the dandelions from turning to seeds.

In conclusion, these services were performed early at NO EXTRA CHARGE. It is simply an example of our dedication to your landscape needs.
